This email confirms our telephone discussion this morning, during which you informed me that the Regional Director has read and considered the Employer's correspondence dated February 18, 2016. The Regional Director's response is that he cannot revoke the certification on his own; however, if the parties wish to jointly petition the Board for that purpose, the Regional Director will not object to such a petition. You further indicated that the Appellate Litigation Branch, not the Region, is responsible for withdrawal of the petition for enforcement and that we can rely on Mimi Rajapakse's January 4, 2016 email with respect to that issue.

This also confirms that the Region has provided an extension to Monday, February 22, 2016 at 4:30 p.m. Hawaii Time, so that the parties can obtain executed versions of the settlement agreement and submit the appropriate paperwork to the Region.
