Dear Mr. Kramer and Mr. Dritsas:

Yesterday I issued a letter in the above-referenced case denying your March 29, 2016 Motion Requesting Increased Page Limit for Request for Review ("Motion"). In this Motion, you requested that the Board grant permission to increase the 50 page limit on the Respondent's brief in support of request for review to 100 pages.

I denied your Motion as untimely under Section 102.46(j) of the Board's Rules and Regulations, which states that permission to submit a brief in excess of 50 pages must be sought no less than 10 days prior to the date the brief is due. However, the Board's Rules and Regulations, as revised pursuant to the new Representation case Rules, states in Section 102.67(i)(1) that permission to exceed the page limit for a request for review in a Representation case can be obtained from the Board by motion filed not less than 5 days prior to the date the document is due. As your Motion was filed 6 days prior to the due date for the request for review, it is timely. You have explained thoroughly the Respondent's need for additional pages in this case. Therefore, the Motion for extension of pages is granted. This extension of pages applies to all parties.
