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**STATUS REPORT OF THE  
NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD**

To the Honorable, the Judges of the United States  
Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Deputy Associate  
General Counsel, provides this status report pursuant to the Court’s February 2,  
2016 order. In that order, the Court granted the Board’s unopposed motion to hold  
this case in abeyance, pending the Petitioner’s voluntary compliance with the

Board Order under review here. *See* 362 NLRB No. 150, 2015 WL 4512357 (2015). The Court, however, required the parties to file status reports addressing the status of compliance on April 4, 2016, and every 60 days thereafter, until the compliance process is complete.

The Board hereby informs the Court that the Petitioner has complied with nearly all of its obligations under the Board's Order. The Board is awaiting confirmation that Petitioner has met with its employees' collective-bargaining representative for good-faith bargaining, and has posted a remedial notice for 60 consecutive days, as required under the Order. 362 NLRB No. 150, 2015 WL 4512357, at \*4. Upon confirmation that Petitioner has taken these steps, the Board will consider the compliance process complete and will be prepared to voluntarily dismiss its appeal.
