**THE NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD’S STATUS REPORT ON
CASE HELD IN ABEYANCE PENDING MEDIATION**

To the Honorable, the Judges of the United States
Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Deputy Associate General Counsel, respectfully notifies the Court that the parties are continuing their efforts to settle this case, and further shows:

1. On December 18, 2015, the Court granted the Board’s unopposed motion to hold the case in abeyance pending mediation. The Court further directed the parties to file status reports at 60-day intervals beginning February 16, 2016. The next status report is due April 18.

2. As of today, April 12, the parties have signed a settlement agreement and are in the process of complying with its terms. Pursuant to the Court’s order, the Board will file a motion to govern further court proceedings within 30 days of the

completion of settlement proceedings, and will file another update within the next 60 days.

WHEREFORE, the Board respectfully notifies the Court that the parties are currently working to settle the above-captioned case.
