The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”) provides the following
update regarding the above-captioned case:

1. On October 15, 2015, the Court placed this case in abeyance pending
the outcome of *Murphy Oil USA, Inc. v. NLRB*, 808 F.3d 1013 (5th Cir. 2015), and
instructed that a “Stay Follow-up” be filed. On March 7, 2016, the Court updated
the Stay Follow-up deadline to April 19, 2016.

2. On February 18, 2016, the Court entered judgment in *Murphy Oil*.

The Board's petition for rehearing was filed on April 18, 2016. Subsequently, on April 19, 2016, the Board filed a corrected copy of the petition for rehearing.
