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**UNOPPOSED MOTION
OF THE NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD
FOR A 30-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME**

To the Honorable, the Judges of the United States
Court of Appeals for Fifth Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Deputy Associate General Counsel, respectfully moves this Court for a 30-day extension of time to submit its brief, to and including June 30, 2016. In support of its motion, the Board shows as follows:

1. Citi Trends, Incorporated (“the Company”), filed its brief on April 25, 2016. The Board’s brief is due May 31, 2016.
2. Kira Dellinger Vol, the supervisory attorney assigned to this case, has significant responsibilities in other cases, including *Convergys Corp. v. NLRB*, 5th Cir. No. 15-60860 (brief due May 11); *Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal*

Government v. NLRB, Supreme Court No. 15-1024 (response to petition for certiorari due May 18); *Soaring Eagle Casino & Resort v. NLRB*, Supreme Court No. 15-1034 (response to petition for certiorari due May 18); *Price-Simms, Inc. v. NLRB*, D.C. Cir. Nos. 15-1457, 16-1010 (brief due May 27); and *AT&T Mobility Services, LLC v. NLRB*, D.C. Cir. Nos. 16-1099, 16-1159 (brief due May 27).

3. Due to Board counsel's above-described commitments, it will not be possible for Board counsel, with due diligence and giving priority to the preparation and editing of the brief, to file the brief by its current due date. The Board has not previously requested an extension of time in this case. The Board therefore requests an additional 30 days, until Thursday, June 30, 2016, to file its brief.

4. Counsel for the Company does not oppose such an extension.

WHEREFORE, the Board respectfully requests that the Court grant a 30-day extension of the due date of the Board's brief, to and including June 30, 2016.
