ERRATUM

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Second Amendment to Second Consolidated Complaint which issued on April 26, 2016, is hereby corrected to substitute the following paragraph as set forth below:

As part of the remedy for the unfair labor practices alleged above in paragraphs 5, 6, 7 and 9, the General Counsel seeks an Order requiring that at a meeting or meetings scheduled to ensure the widest possible attendance, Respondent's representative to read the notice to the employees in English, Spanish (or another language) on work time in the presence of a Board agent. Alternatively, the General Counsel seeks an order requiring that Respondent promptly have a Board agent read the notice to employees during work time in the presence of Respondent's supervisors and agents identified above in **paragraph 4**. In the alternative, if Respondent's operations are not

ordered restored to the Middlesboro, Kentucky facility, Respondent should be ordered to rent a facility at its own expense, at a location and time determined appropriate by the Regional Director, where Unit employees can assemble and be read the Notice in the manner described above.
