We represent Respondent Pinnacle Dietary Inc. ("Pinnacle") in the above-referenced matter. On April 29, 2016, a decision was issued in this case. Exceptions are currently due on June 27, 2016.

The parties are actively engaged in settlement discussions. A settlement agreement has been circulated and the parties continue to negotiate mutually-acceptable terms. Based on the productivity of the recent discussions, we are hopeful the parties will execute an agreement within the next three weeks.

To that end, we request a three-week extension of time to file exceptions to afford the parties an opportunity to devote full attention and resources to settlement. We have spoken with counsel for Budget Services, Inc., who joins in our request for an extension. We have also spoken with counsel for General Counsel, who consents to our request.
