Dear Ms. Garcia:

This correspondence constitutes Teamsters Local 63's ("Local 63") request for an extension of time to file a Request for Review in the above-referenced matter.

On June 7, 2016, Local 63 was served with the Regional Director's Decision and Order ("Order"). To avoid unnecessary expense, Local 63 did not order a copy of the hearing transcripts until after it decided to request a review of the Order. Local 63 only received a copy of the transcripts on June 20, 2016, a day before its Request for Review is due.

Since the Request for Review is required to be a self-contained document with any relevant testimony or evidence summarized, Local 63's inability to access the transcripts substantially hindered its preparation of the Request. *See* 29 C.F.R. § 102.67(i)(1).

Local 63 requests a seven-day extension of its time to file the Request for Review, which is a reasonable time to allow Local 63 to utilize the transcript in support of its Request for Review. Local 63 contacted the Employer's counsel the morning of June 20, 2016 to ask that the Employer stipulate to this extension, but as of the filing of this request, no stipulation has been reached. The Board should grant this reasonable extension.

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
