NOTICE TO SHOW CAUSE

On January 30, 2015, the Employer, CPL (Linwood) LLC d/b/a Linwood Care Center, filed an RM petition with Region 4 of the National Labor Relations Board. Subsequently, the Regional Director for Region 4, Dennis P. Walsh, administratively dismissed the RM petition because of meritorious unfair labor practice charges filed against the Employer. The Employer then filed with the Board a timely request for review of the Regional Director's administrative dismissal of the petition. On February 17, 2016, the Board denied the request for review. Subsequently, the Employer filed a timely Motion for Reconsideration. In the intervening period between the filing of the petition and the motion for reconsideration, the Employer ceased to be the employer of the members of the bargaining unit involved in this matter. Accordingly,

NOTICE IS GIVEN that cause be shown, in writing, filed with the Board in Washington, D.C., on or before August 11, 2016 (with affidavit of service on the parties to this proceeding), as to why the Board should not find that the RM petition is now moot

in light of the fact that the RM petitioner is no longer the employer of any of the bargaining unit employees.
