Dear Petitioner's Counsel,

The following pertains to your petition for panel rehearing electronically filed on November 14, 2016.

The rehearing is insufficient for the following reason and must be corrected within the next **14 days**:

- Counsel is hereby advised that this Court does not allow one attorney to use his/her Electronic Case Filing (ECF) user name and password to electronically file documents on another attorney's behalf.

In this instance, the ECF user name and password of attorney Sarah Voorhies Myers was used to electronically file the petition for panel rehearing that is ONLY electronically signed by attorney G. Phillip Shuler, III, which is unacceptable. Counsel must choose from the following options-

- a. Replace all the electronic signatures of attorney G. Phillip Shuler, III, with that of attorney Sarah Voorhies Myers; Or,

**Once you have prepared your sufficient rehearing, you must email it to: [dantrell\\_johnson@ca5.uscourts.gov](mailto:dantrell_johnson@ca5.uscourts.gov) for review.** If the rehearing is in compliance, you will receive a notice of docket activity advising you that the sufficient rehearing has been filed.

Failure to timely make the petition for panel rehearing sufficient via e-mail may result in the petition for panel rehearing being stricken.
