**GENERAL COUNSEL'S RESPONSE TO JOINT MOTION FOR REMAND**

Following a trial on the merits and a Decision and Recommended Order by Administrative Law Judge Christine Dibble which issued on April 13, 2016, and which sustained all significant aspects of the consolidated complaint, Office and Professional Employees International Union, Local 12, the Charging Party, and TruStone Financial Federal Credit Union, the Respondent, filed a Joint Motion for Remand on October 17, 2016, requesting that the above cases be remanded to the Regional Director for consideration of a Charging Party request to withdraw the charges. Respondent's exceptions to the Board were pending at the time of the October 17, 2016 motion.

The parties have recently agreed to resolve all aspects of this dispute, including reaching and signing a collective bargaining agreement which provides for recognition of the Union at two relocated branches, offers of reinstatement to affected employees, and remediation of any economic losses suffered by employees, among other things. The agreement reached by the parties remedies the violations found by ALJ Dibble and is otherwise satisfactory to the Regional Director.

Therefore, as the remedy in this matter has been obtained, there is no purpose in continuing to process these cases. The General Counsel joins in the parties' request that the Board remand these cases to the Regional Director for consideration of a withdrawal request.
