
Dear Secretary Shinnors:

I represent the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 225 ("IBEW Local 225") and am writing you to inquire as to the status of the pending Employer's Request for Review of the Regional Directors Decision and Order in case number 14-RC-168543. The Employer's request was file on March 1, 2016 and our corresponding Opposition to the Request for Review of the Regional Directors Decision and Direction of Election was filed on March 8, 2016. The certification of representative was issued on March 8, 2016.

Since the issuance of the certification of representative was issued on March 8, 2016, the Employer has refused to recognize or bargain with IBEW Local 225 and has also subjected one of the covered employees to adverse employment actions in retaliation for testifying at the ptc-election hearing on February 5, 2016. These cases are currently being held in abeyance by the Regional Director pending the outcome of the Employer's Request for Review.

The Union is concerned that the longer this case continues to pend without resolution, more unlawful conduct will occur and the Union's efforts to protect the covered employees will become more and more difficult. We would appreciate any information your office may provide as to the timeline for which we may expect a decision on the currently pending request for review in 14-RC-168543.
