The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Deputy Associate General Counsel, respectfully notifies the Court that the parties are continuing their efforts to settle this case, and further shows:

1. On December 18, 2015, the Court granted the Board’s unopposed motion to hold the case in abeyance pending mediation. The Court further directed the parties to file periodic status reports.

2. As of today, March 3, 2017, the parties have signed a settlement agreement and have completed the process of complying with its terms. Pursuant to the Court’s order, the Board will file a motion to govern further court proceedings within 30 days of this status report, and will file another update within the next 60 days, if necessary.
