JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE came to be heard upon a petition filed by Columbia College Chicago ("Columbia") to review an Order of the National Labor Relations Board ("Board") dated March 24, 2016, in Case Nos. 13-CA-073486, 13-CA-073487, 13-CA-076794, 13-CA-078080, 13-CA-081162 and 13-CA-084369, reported at 363 NLRB No. 154, and upon a cross-application for enforcement filed by the National Labor Relations Board to enforce said Order. The Court heard argument of all parties and has considered the briefs and agency record filed in this cause. On February 2, 2017, the Court, being fully advised in the premises, handed down its opinion granting in part the petition of Columbia College Chicago and granting in part the Board's cross-petition for enforcement. In conformity therewith, it is hereby ORDERED:

We GRANT Columbia's petition for review, and GRANT in part and DENY in part the NLRB's application for enforcement of the Board's order. We VACATE the order's effects-bargaining and negotiation-expense components, summarily enforce the remainder, and REMAND for further proceedings consistent with the opinion. The above is in accordance with the decision of this court entered on February 2, 2017. Each party shall bear their own costs.
