ORDER DENYING MOTIONS¹

The Respondents' motions for summary judgment dismissing the complaint are denied. This denial is without prejudice to the Respondents' right to renew their deferral arguments to the administrative law judge, after presenting evidence, and to raise the deferral issue before the Board on any exceptions that may be filed to the judge's decision, if appropriate.
