Dear Counsel:

On October 19, 2017, Administrative Law Judge Kenneth Chu issued a decision in the above-referenced case. On October 31, 2017, Counsel for the General Counsel filed a motion titled "Counsel for the General Counsel's Post Decision Motion to Modify the Conclusions of Law, Order and Remedy to Conform to the Administrative Law Judge's 10/19/2017 Decision" with the NLRB's Division of Judges. On November 1, 2017, Judge Chu issued an *errata* addressing the issues raised in Counsel for the General Counsel's motion.

On November 15, 2017, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel filed the same motion with the Board.
