This will acknowledge the receipt in this Office on January 10, 2018 of the Charging Party's Motion for Reconsideration of the Board's December 13, 2017 decision in the subject case. This Motion for Reconsideration, however, is procedurally deficient and thus cannot be forwarded to the Board for consideration.

Section 102.48(c)(1) of the Board's Rules and Regulations provides, in relevant part, that "[a] motion for reconsideration must state with particularity the material error claimed and with respect to any finding of material fact, must specify the page of the record relied on." Here, the Charging Party has failed to provide with specificity the material error claimed in the Board's December 13, 2017 decision. Further, the Charging Party has failed to serve this Motion for Reconsideration on the other parties in this case pursuant to Section 102.5(f) of the Board's Rules and Regulations. It is for these reasons that the Motion for Reconsideration is rejected.
