SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE TO SHOW CAUSE

On December 22, 2017, the General Counsel filed with the National Labor Relations Board Motions to Transfer and Continue Matter before the Board and for Default Judgment on the ground that the Respondent has failed to file an answer to the Complaint and Notice of Hearing. On January 3, 2018, the Board issued an Order transferring this proceeding and a Notice to Show Cause why the motion should not be granted. However, as of the date that a response was due, the tracking system of the United States Postal Service indicated that the Order had not been delivered at either of the two addresses for the Respondent. Accordingly, this supplemental notice is being issued to the Respondent at those addresses and the addresses for the Respondent's registered agent, extending the deadline for a response.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that any party seeking to show cause why the General Counsel's motion should not be granted must do so in writing, filed with the Board in Washington, D.C., on or before February 1, 2018 (with affidavit of service on the parties to this proceeding). Any briefs or statements in support of the motion shall be filed by the same date.
