The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”) provides the following update regarding the above-captioned case:

1. On September 21, 2016, the Court placed this case in abeyance until the Supreme Court proceedings in *Murphy Oil USA, Inc. v. NLRB* (No. 16-307), *Lewis v. Epic Sys. Corp.* (No. 16-285), and *Morris v. Ernst & Young, LLP* (No. 16-300) are completed, and instructed that a stay follow up be filed.
2. The cases were briefed and oral argument was held October 2, 2017. Therefore, the proceedings are not completed and it is appropriate for this

case to remain in abeyance.
