Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”) provides the following update regarding the above-captioned case:

1. On November 1, 2016, the Court placed this case in abeyance pending Supreme Court proceedings in three related cases, *NLRB v. Murphy Oil USA, Inc., et al*, No. 16-307; *Lewis v. Epic Sys. Corp.*, No. 16-285; and *Morris v. Ernst & Young, LLP*, No. 16-300, and instructed that a “Stay Follow-up” be filed.

2. The cases were briefed and oral argument was held October 2, 2017. Therefore, the proceedings are not completed and it is appropriate for this case to remain in abeyance.
