NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT REACHED BY PARTIES

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on April 23, 2018, the California Nurses Association/National Nurses United (the “Union”), intervenor in the above-captioned action, announced that the Union had ratified a new five-year collective bargaining contract with the Kaiser Permanente entities who employ registered nurses and nurse practitioners represented by the Union throughout Northern and Central California, including employees of Kaiser Foundation Hospitals and The Permanente Medical Group, Inc. (collectively “Petitioners”).

As a part of the collective bargaining agreement, Petitioners agreed to recognize the Union as the exclusive representative of the unit of patient care coordinators, as described in NLRB Case No. 20-RC-188438 (the “Unit”), and to

integrate the Unit into the collective bargaining agreement with the Union.

Petitioners and the Union further agreed to settle all pending litigation related to representational status of the Unit, including NLRB Case No. 20-CA-202724 and United States Court of Appeal, District of Columbia Circuit Case Numbers 18-1004 and 18-1035.

Counsel for Petitioners have advised counsel for Respondent, the National Labor Relations Board, regarding this settlement. The parties are taking the steps necessary to resolve this matter in its entirety. Petitioners intend to file and will file the appropriate dismissal as soon as possible.
