Dear Mr. Langer:

I am writing to bring the Court's attention to a typographical error in its opinion in the above-captioned case, which issued on May 8, 2018. On page 8, the Court quotes the Board's decision as stating, "[a]t a minimum, the policy — as a rule adopted by and imposed on members — can reasonably be interpreted to give ultimate authority to [Local 58]." This quotation omits two words from the Board's decision, which states, in relevant part, "as a rule adopted by *the Respondent* and imposed on members." (Appendix 86 n. 10) (emphasis added.) Local 58 was the Respondent before the Board. The Board respectfully submits that the quotation in the Court's opinion should read, in relevant part: "as a rule adopted by [Local 58] and imposed on members."
