**MOTION TO CHANGE THE HEARING DATE.**

Pursuant to Section 102.16 of the Board's Rules and Regulations, Respondent International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150, AFL-CIO ("Local 150"), respectfully moves to change the June 11, 2018 hearing date in this matter. Local 150, in good faith, requests a thirty (30)-day extension. In support of this Motion, Local 150 proffers the following proper cause:

1. The compliance hearing date is currently set for June 11, 2018, in Grand Rapids, Michigan.
2. On May 23, 2018, the Administrative Law Judge held a conference call with Respondent, counsel for General Counsel and counsel for Interested Party MacAllister Machinery Inc.
3. The conference call resulted: 1) in Local 150 clarifying and thus amending its Answer to the Compliance Specification (First Amended Answer filed on May 25, 2018); and 2) prompting Local 150 to reconsider settlement.

4. Local 150, therefore, now seeks to direct its time and resources towards reaching a settlement in this matter, and requests a 30-day extension of the hearing date to work on a settlement.

5. On March 25, 2018, counsel for Respondent contacted Charging Party about changing the hearing date: Charging Party objected to moving the hearing date.

6. On March 25, 2018, counsel for Respondent contacted counsel for General Counsel about changing the hearing date to provide time for meaningful settlement discussions. Counsel for General Counsel stated he needed to talk with the front office and that he would get back to counsel for Respondent with the Region's position on the extension. To date, counsel for General Counsel has not indicated its official position on the requested extension.

7. Counsel for General Counsel has a high school graduation on June 14, 2018, and a pre-planned, paid-for vacation, out of the country, June 15 through 25, 2018.

8. The request to move the hearing date is made for good cause and not to delay the hearing.

9. No party will be prejudiced by the extension.

WHEREFORE, Local 150 respectfully requests that this Motion be granted and the hearing date in this matter be extended thirty (30) days.
