¹ Please note that NLRB Rules and Regulations Section 102.46(e) states that “[n]o extensions of time will be granted for the filing of reply briefs . . .”. The due date for answering briefs to exceptions was July 6, 2018, and reply briefs to answering brief to exceptions was July 20, 2018. However, we will allow the requested extension because, on July 6, 2018, the NLRB’s E-Filing system was in technical failure and the NLRB’s website stated that “[i]n accordance with the Agency’s E-File Terms and Conditions, the due date for E-Filed documents due to be filed on July 6, 2018, is extended to Monday, July 9, 2018 at 11:59 p.m. (Eastern Time).” The General Counsel and Charging Party filed answering briefs on July 9, 2018 in accordance with this extension. Under these unusual circumstances, we grant the same one-business day extension for the filing of reply briefs so as to allow the same amount of time for review of the answering briefs and drafting of a reply as would otherwise have been afforded in the absence of the technical failure.
