

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

Dear: Mr. Alibocas

This is in response to your recent indication to us that due to financial difficulties, the company is proposing changes in the work force for which we are the exclusive and certified collective bargaining representative. The IAM has a vital stake in being able to assess the economic justification of the company's decision to terminate two employees, the effects that any company decision may have on the affected employees we represent, and to consider all available alternatives.

Accordingly, the following is information that we feel is necessary for us to properly represent our members.

- 1) Financial statements for this facility:
 - a) The audited Statement of Income for the past five fiscal years.
 - b) The Statement of Income for the current fiscal year year-to-date and the comparable period for the prior year.
 - c) The audited Balance Sheet for the past five fiscal years.
 - d) The Balance Sheet for the current fiscal year year-to-date and the comparable period for the prior year.
 - e) All notes associated with the above financial statements.
 - f) If not included in the Statement of Income or notes to the financial statements, a breakdown by major category for the past five fiscal years and for the most recent accounting period for the current fiscal year of sales, cost of goods/services sold, and selling, general & administrative expenses.
 - g) Material Loss in Revenue for 2016 year.

- 2) Business Plans/Studies/Reviews
 - a) Copies of all plans, studies or reviews made regarding the future ongoing

- economic viability of this facility.
- b) Copies of all plans, studies, reviews, forecasts and budgets on the expected performance of this facility.
 - c) Copies of all plans, studies, or reviews related to the restructuring, reorganizing, or other efforts to respond to the financial problems.
 - d) Copies of all plans, studies or reviews showing the justification for the proposed changes to the current Status Quo.
 - e) Details concerning any cuts in wages and/or fringe benefits to other employee groups, both unionized and non-unionized, as a result of the current situation.
 - f) Breakdown of labor costs as a percentage of Spartan Products total costs of operations.
 - g)
- 3) Discussion of Competition
- a) Data regarding Spartan Products competition, primarily relating to the New Competitor and their operations at all U.S Virgin Islands.
 - b) Data supporting the company's position that New Competitor is able to maintain a cost advantage over Spartan Products.
 - c) Information regarding any advantages conferred by New Competitor due to Foreign Trade Zone status.
- 4) Bargaining Unit Work and Benefits
- a) Company plan on how the welding, yardman and maintenance work will be performed.
 - b) Company needs to explain who will be performing the welding, yardman and maintenance work.
 - c) Company needs to provide all amounts of accrual benefits and total compensation payout.
 - d) Company needs to provide recall language for affected employees.

JOINT STIPULATION OF FACTS AND DOCUMENTS

The undersigned, duly authorized representatives of the General Counsel, Spartan Products, LLC (hereinafter "Respondent"), and International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, AFL-CIO (hereinafter "the Union") hereby stipulate to the following:

1. At all material times, the Union has been a labor organization within the meaning of Section 2(5) of the Act.
2. At all material times, Dion Alibocas has held the position of General Manager. Halvor Berg held the position of Batch Plant Manager as of and before January 30, 2017, and voluntarily resigned his position on July 26, 2017. Both were "supervisors" of Respondent within the meaning of Section 2(11) of the Act and "agents" of Respondent within the meaning of Section 2(13) of the Act.
3. The following employees of Respondent, herein called the Unit, constitute a unit appropriate for the purposes of collective-bargaining within the meaning of Section 9(b) of the Act:

All full-time and regular part-time truck drivers, mechanics, welders, painters, laborers, and loaders or loader operators; excluding: All office clerical employee professional employees, managerial employees, confidential employees, guards, and supervisors as defined in the Act.



4. On or about January 31, 2017, Respondent laid off employee Ramon Murrain-Benjamin, a welder.

5. On or about February 1, 2017, Respondent laid off employee Benson Morton, a yard man.

6. On February 23, 2017, two dates in mid-April 2017, May 11, 2017, July 24, 2017, October 20, 2017, November 15, 2017, February 13, 2018, February 27, 2018, and March 7, 2018, a welder from Heavy Materials, LLC, , an entity separate from Respondent at all material times, performed welding tasks at Respondent's facility.

7. Respondent did not give prior notice to the Union and did not discuss the welding tasks referenced in paragraph 6 above.

8. On February 3, 2017, the Union sent a document request to Respondent asking for financial and other records.

9. Between February 3, 2017, and May 15, 2017, the Union and Respondent's counsel communicated via telephone concerning the terms of a proposed collective bargaining agreement and corresponded with Respondent via email on at least twelve (12) separate occasions concerning the same subject.

10. At no time between February 3, 2017, and April 28, 2017, did the Union make a second request for the documents it requested on February 3, 2017.

11. **Joint Exhibit 1** constitutes two (2) emails with attachments dated January 30, 2017, from Respondent's counsel to the Union, constituting the first communication to the Union regarding the layoffs of Murrain and Morton.

12. **Joint Exhibit 2** constitutes an e-mail dated January 31, 2017, from the Union to Respondent in response to Joint Exhibit 1 above.

13. **Joint Exhibit 3** constitutes an e-mail dated January 31, 2017, from the Union to Respondent's counsel in response to Joint Exhibit 1 above.

14. **Joint Exhibit 4** constitutes a letter dated January 31, 2017, sent by certified mail from Respondent to former employee Ramon Murrain.






