ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO POSTPONE HEARING

This matter is currently set for a hearing on September 5, 2018, in Phoenix, Arizona.

On August 14, 2018, Respondent counsel filed a motion to postpone the September 5 hearing in this matter “until September 20, 21, 24, 25, or 26, 2018” so that the Respondent and General Counsel can work out a joint stipulated record to waive a hearing since at that point there will be no facts in dispute.

Today, before noon, the Counsel for the General Counsel (CGC) filed his response to the Motion saying that the CGC “does not oppose postponement of the hearing to allow time for negotiation of a stipulated record and agrees this matter may lend itself to litigation based on a stipulated record.”


I find that good cause has been shown to grant the Motion and postpone the September 5 hearing to October 23, 2018. The San Francisco Division of Judges does not have any open slots to schedule a hearing on any of the suggested dates by Respondent.

With no opposition, **IT IS ORDERED** that the Respondent’s motion to postpone hearing to a date on or after late September 2018 is **GRANTED** and the hearing shall be **CONTINUED** from September 5, 2018 to *a date no earlier than Tuesday, October 23, 2018*, as determined by the Regional Director for Region 28 pursuant to Section 102.16(b) of the Board’s Rules and Regulations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Regional Director for further handling consistent with this Order to set a new date, time, and location for hearing in this case.
