**JOINT REQUEST TO WITHDRAW JOINT MOTION TO TRANSFER PROCEEDING
TO BOARD ON STIPULATED RECORD AND
JOINT MOTION TO REMAND CASE TO REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR REGION SIX**

Counsel for the General Counsel for the National Labor Relations Board (General Counsel), Charging Party International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 126, AFL-CIO (Charging Party), and C.W. Wright Construction Company (Respondent), collectively referred to as the Parties, jointly request to withdraw the pending Joint Motion to Transfer Proceeding to Board on Stipulated Record, and jointly move to remand the above-captioned case to the Regional Director for Region Six for further processing.

On February 27, 2017, the General Counsel, through the Regional Director for Region Six, issued a Complaint and Notice of Hearing alleging that the Respondent has maintained several rules in its Policy and Procedures Manual. The complaint alleges that, by the foregoing conduct, the Respondent has violated Section 8(a)(1) of the Act by interfering with, restraining, and coercing employees in the exercise of their Section 7 rights.

On September 27, 2017, the parties filed with the Board a Joint Motion to Transfer Proceeding to Board on Stipulated Record.

On October 1, 2018, the Board issued a Notice to Show Cause why this case should not be remanded to the Regional Director for Region Six for further proceedings in light of the Board's decision in *The Boeing Co.*, 365 NLRB No. 154 (2017).

The parties request remand so that the Regional Director may seek guidance from the Division of Advice regarding further processing of the instant case consistent with the Board's decision in *Boeing*. Therefore, the parties respectfully request that the Board remand the instant case to the Regional Director for Region Six, and grant the joint request of the parties to withdraw the previously filed Joint Motion to Transfer Proceeding to Board on Stipulated Record.
