RESPONDENTS' JOINDER IN COUNSEL FOR THE GENERAL COUNSEL'S  
OPPOSITION TO THE BOARD'S ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On November 20, 2018, the Board issued a Notice to Show Cause why this case should not be remanded to the administrative law judge for further proceedings in light of the Board's decision in *The Boeing Co.*, 365 NLRB No. 154, slip op. at 14-17 (2017). The specific issue to be addressed on remand is whether the Respondents maintained an arbitration policy that, while neutral on its face, nevertheless restricted employees' access to the Board in violation of Section 8(a)(1) based on the new standard expressed in *Boeing*.

On December 3, 2018, Counsel for the General Counsel served opposition to remand, on the ground that the sole issue in this case is currently pending before the Board in another case, *Prime Healthcare*, 21-CA-133781. Respondents hereby join in the opposition served by Counsel

for the General Counsel, as the Board deciding the issues before it in *Prime Healthcare*, will likely obviate the need to remand this case where the same issue is presented.
