**ORDER FOR LAW-DEN TO SHOW CAUSE WHY
IT SHOULD NOT BE HELD IN CONTEMPT AND
RESCHEDULING STATUS CONFERENCE**

The Court ordered the parties to submit a Joint Proposed Discovery Plan. Instead, the National Labor Relations Board (“NLRB”) submitted a Proposed Discovery Plan in which it says counsel for Law-Den Nursing Home (“Law-Den”) failed to respond to attempts to confer on a Joint Plan.

Law-Den is ordered to immediately contact counsel for NLRB so that a Joint Discovery Plan can be submitted.

Law Den’s failure to contact the NLRB immediately, so that a Joint Plan can be submitted by the close of business Friday, December 21, 2018, may result in Law-Den being held in contempt of Court, or the Court may consider other relief it deems appropriate.

The Status Conference by phone set for Wednesday, December 19, 2018 at 4:30 pm is adjourned to Thursday, January 3, 2019 at 1:30 pm. Counsel for Petitioner must initiate the call.
