Dear Ms. Reardon:

I write on behalf of Counsel for the General Counsel, Respondent, and the Charging Party to request that the current date for Answering Briefs be stayed pending the filing and consideration by the Board of the parties' joint motion to remand this matter to the Regional Director for processing of the Charging Party's withdrawal request pursuant to a non-Board settlement.

On August 8, 2018, Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision (ALJD) were filed by the General Counsel, and the Respondent. The Charging Party also joined in the General Counsel's exceptions. Since that time the parties have requested several extensions on the due date for the filing of Answering Briefs because the Charging Party and Respondent have been working towards a global non-Board settlement of the instant matter and other pending litigation. The current due date for the filing of Answering Briefs is January 29, 2019.

Last week the parties forwarded the executed and finalized settlement documents to the Region. The parties are currently preparing a joint motion seeking that this matter be remanded to the Regional Director to process the Charging Party's withdrawal request made in light of the settlement reached. The General Counsel, Respondent and the Charging Party intend to file their joint motion in the next couple of days but in the meantime ask that the due date for the filing of Answering Briefs be stayed pending the Board's receipt and review of the parties' joint motion.
