Gordon, presiding in the United States District Court of Nevada in Case 2:18-cv-02187-APG-NJK, issued an order granting temporary injunctive relief pursuant to 29 U.S.C. § 160(j) (Section 10(j) of the Act), upon which numerous allegations pending before the ALJ in the instant matter provided the basis for such relief. Accordingly, CGC respectfully requests that the ALJ give the instant matter

priority “over all other cases except cases of like character,” as required under Section 102.94 of the Board’s Rules and Regulations, as amended.
