of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Assistant General
Counsel, states as follows:

1. As directed by the Court in its January 25, 2019 order, the Board
submits this status report regarding its motion to postpone oral argument in this
case pending settlement.

2. The parties have reached an agreement to settle this matter, but require additional time to effect the settlement.

3. The Board anticipates that it will file a motion to dismiss its application for enforcement and that Planned Building Services, Inc., will file a motion to dismiss its petition for review within the next 90 days, assuming compliance with the parties' settlement agreement in the interim.

4. The Board respectfully requests that the Court continue to hold this case in abeyance so that the parties can continue to resolve the matter.

5. Counsel for PBS, Marvin Weinberg, has authorized the Board to file this status report as a joint representation of the status of the case.
