As you are aware, the undersigned represents the interest of The Leaguers, Inc. in connection with the above referenced matter.

This letter follows our telephone conference on today's date, wherein, you inquired about the status of negotiations with CWA.

As discussed, enormous progress has been made between the parties regarding settlement of the Collective Bargaining Agreement. We are near the goal line, but not quite over it. One issue remains unresolved and that is the 403B Employee Retirement Plan. CWA provided a proposal and the Leaguers presented a counter proposal. Per Mr. Mintz, he has forwarded the Leaguers counter proposal to the Union and he is awaiting a response. Based upon the foregoing, this letter is written to respectfully request that the NLRB suspend issuance of the auto-adoption of the Decision of the Administrative Law Judge as settlement is imminent.
