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<sup>1</sup> Please note that NLRB Rules and Regulations Section 102.2(c) states that “[r]equests for extensions of time filed within three days of the due date must be grounded upon circumstances not reasonably foreseeable in advance.” The due date for exceptions is April 8, 2019 and the request for an extension of time was filed on April 5, 2019 which is only one business day prior to the document’s due date. Despite being filed within three days of the due date, there is no explanation in the request for extension of time as to why the need for the extension was “not reasonably foreseeable in advance.” However, given that Counsel for the General Counsel does not oppose the extension, and the amount of additional time requested is not excessive, we will allow the extension.
