The General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board having duly considered the matter, deeming it necessary in order to effectuate the purposes of the National Labor Relations Act, and to avoid unnecessary costs or delay,

HEREBY ORDERS that for the period May 1, 2019 through August 30, 2019, from time to time:

These cases will automatically transfer back to the Regions in which they originated and processing of these cases will continue in those Regions, to the extent necessary, upon the earliest of the following: the appeal expiration date has passed and no appeal has been filed after the issuance of a letter by the Regional Director of the transferee Region deferring further proceedings on the charge pursuant to the Board's *Collyer/Dubo* policy; completion of the investigation with recommendations for further processing in the originating Region; or closing of the case.
