ORDER DENYING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO  
POSTPONE THE HEARING DATE

On May 31, 2019, counsel for the Respondent moved to delay the start of the hearing scheduled for June 11. The counsel for the General Counsel opposes the motion to postpone.

For the reasons set forth in the counsel for the General Counsel's opposition to the postponement, the Respondent's motion to postpone is denied. In the motion to postpone, the Respondent complained that it would be prejudice at the hearing because there is a pending special appeal before the Board. However, I would note that even a short delay in the proceeding would substantially prejudice the 53 discriminatees who have been waiting years for monetary relief. I would further note that the special appeal identifies only 21 discriminatees and there is no reason why the parties cannot proceed with the remaining discriminatees pending a decision from the Board. Finally, the parties have had ample time to prepare and discuss settlement of this matter for several months. The parties are free to continue settlement discussions.

As such, the Respondent's motion is denied and the hearing scheduled for June 11, 2019 is firm.
