**COUNSEL FOR THE GENERAL COUNSEL'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW
EXCEPTIONS TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S DECISION**

On April 30, 2019, Administrative Law Judge Michael A. Rosas issued his Decision in the matter of Capitol Transportation, Inc., Cases 12-CA-180495 et al., reported at JD-40-19 (ALJD). In his Decision, the ALJ inadvertently omitted from the recommended Remedy, Board Order and Notice to Employees certain provisions that are necessary to effectuate the policies of the Act. As a result, on May 22, 2019, Counsel for the General Counsel filed a Motion for Erratum to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision seeking the ALJ to correct the apparent inadvertent omissions from his recommended Remedy, Board Order and Notice to Employees that are necessary to effectuate the policies of the Act, consistent with the ALJ's findings of fact, conclusions of law, recommended cease and desist orders and Notice to Employees.

On May 28, 2019, Counsel for the General Counsel also filed Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision, seeking the Board to correct the ALJ's above-mentioned

inadvertent omissions. On that same day, after Counsel for the General Counsel filed its Exceptions, the ALJ issued an Erratum to JD-40-19, correcting the recommended Remedy, Board Order and Notice to Employees as requested by Counsel for the General Counsel in its Motion dated May 22, 2019. Since through the Erratum the ALJ addressed and corrected the apparent omissions in his Decision, Counsel for the General Counsel hereby requests that the Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision filed on May 28, 2019, in the instant matter, be withdrawn.
