**COUNSEL FOR THE GENERAL COUNSEL'S MOTION TO SEVER THE CASES AND  
APPROVE THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

1. On March 1, 2019, a Consolidated Complaint and Notice of Hearing issued.
2. On March 26, 2019, an Order Further Consolidating Cases, Second Consolidated Complaint and Notice of Hearing issued in Cases 13-CA-225984, 13-CA-230635, 13-CA-233695, 13-CA-233700, 13-CA-235867, 13-CA-230375, 13-CA-235144, and 13-

CA-235147 alleging that Zeigler North Riverside, LLC, D/B/A/ Zeigler Ford of North Riverside (Respondent North Riverside) and Zeigler Lincolnwood D/B/A Zeigler Buick GMC of Lincolnwood & Cadillac of Lincolnwood (Respondent Lincolnwood) (collectively Respondents) had engaged in unfair labor practices that violate the National Labor Relations Act (the Act), 29 U.S.C. § 151 et seq.

3. On April 22, 2019, a hearing before Administrative Law Judge Charles J. Muhl was held, and the record closed April 23, 2019.
4. On June 10, 2019, after the close of the hearing, all parties reached an Informal Board Settlement on Cases 13-CA-230375, 13-CA-235144, and 13-CA-235147, the charges filed by Teamsters Local 731.
5. That settlement agreement fully remedies all allegations in the Consolidated Complaint relating to the charges filed by Teamsters Local 731. It requires that Respondent Lincolnwood pay the Union's pension fund for all money owed from the date it ceased making payments up to June 20, 2019. It further requires that Respondent Lincolnwood bargain with the Union over any changes to its obligation to contribute to the Union's pension fund. It obligates that the Respondent Lincolnwood refrain from engaging in direct dealing, and it obligates both Respondents to provide the Union with the information it requested August 31, 2018, and January 18, 2019.
6. This is a bilateral settlement. All parties agree with the settlement. None oppose.
7. Resolution of this agreement does not waive the parties' rights in Cases 13-CA-225984, 13-CA-230635, 13-CA-233695, 13-CA-233700 and 13-CA-235867, filed by Local 701.
8. Accordingly, Counsel for the General Counsel asks that you sever these cases and approve the settlement agreement for Cases 13-CA-230375, 13-CA-235144, and 13-CA-235147, filed by Teamsters Local 731, and remand these cases back to the Region for compliance.
