The Respondent's request for special permission to appeal from Administrative Law Judge Benjamin Green's May 20, 2019 ruling is denied. The Respondent failed to demonstrate that the judge abused his discretion in granting the General Counsel's Motion to Strike Portions of Respondent's Answer, and to Preclude Respondent from Questioning Discriminatees Regarding Their Immigration Status or that its arguments regarding the Board's standard for pleading a work authorization-based affirmative defense could not be presented to the Board on exceptions, if necessary.
