**COUNSEL FOR THE GENERAL COUNSEL MOTION TO SEVER AND REMAND
CASE 10-RC-206308**

Counsel for the General Counsel moves that the National Labor Relations Board issue an order severing and remanding Case 10-RC-206308 to the Regional Director of Region 10 for further processing, including the approval of a withdrawal request submitted by United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union (Union). In support of this motion, Counsel for the General Counsel states as follows:

1. On August 28, 2018, the Regional Director issued a report on objections in Case 10-RC-206308 and consolidated the objections for hearing with unfair labor practice Cases 10-CA-208255 and 10-CA-208414.
2. On March 5, 2019, the Regional Director issued an Amended Consolidated Complaint in this matter. An Administrative Law Judge conducted a hearing from March 18 to March 22, 2019.
3. On May 14, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge issued his Decision finding that Respondent violated the Act and recommended that the election in Case 10-RC-206308 be set aside and remanded to the Regional Director for the purpose of conducting a second election.

4. On June 25, 2019, Respondent filed exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision. The exceptions are currently pending before the Board.

5. On July 19, 2019, the Union filed with the Regional Director a request to withdraw the representation petition in Case 10-RC-206308.

6. Respondent does not oppose the Union's request to withdraw Case 10-RC-206308.

7. Counsel for the General Counsel submits that severance of Case 10-RC-206308 and remand to the Regional Director in order to process the Union's withdrawal request is appropriate.

WHEREFORE, in light of the above, and in the interest of effectuating the policies of the Board, Counsel for the General Counsel requests that the Board sever Case 10-RC-206308 and remand it to the Regional Director for further processing.
