**ATU LOCAL 1091's UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR
SUSPENSION OF BRIEFING DUE DATES**

With the consent of Counsel for General Counsel and Counsel for Respondent MV, Charging Party ATU Local 1091 requests a suspension of the briefing due dates.

The current briefing due date is August 14, 2019. At a June 10, 2019 private mediation, Local 1091 and MV reached a settlement in principle which was memorialized in, among other documents, a bilateral informal settlement agreement signed on July 31, 2019 by ATU Local 1091 and on August 1, 2019 by MV. On August 7, 2019, the General Counsel filed "General Counsel's Motion to Remand Case to the Regional Director for Approval of Informal Settlement Agreement" representing that "approval of this settlement would effectuate the purposes of the Act and be in the best interests of the unit employees," and asking that the Board remand the case to allow for the approval and processing of the settlement.

Under these circumstances, ATU Local 1091, with the consent of the other parties, asks that the August 14, 2019 due date for filing cross-exceptions and supporting briefs, and for filing answering briefs (with the March 11, 2019 grant of Charging Party's motion to exceed the page

limits concerning the answering briefs being preserved) be suspended, pending the Board's action on the General Counsel's remand motion, and, if granted, pending the Regional Director's approval and processing of the settlement. This suspension, if granted, is expected to be applicable for all parties.
