We are counsel to Phillips 66 Company - Bayway Refinery ("Employer") in the above-referenced matter. This letter is in response to correspondence received from Farah Z. Qureshi, Associate Executive Secretary, on July 18, 2019 advising that, given the Certification of Results of Election in the subject case (which resulted in a vote of 24-9 against representation), the "Employer's Request for Review of Decision and Direction of Election, filed with the Board on June 26, 2019, is moot and will not be ruled on by the Board."

The Employer disagrees with this decision. Regardless, the Employer will continue to deal with the Console Supervisors as it has in the past, as statutory supervisors.
