JOINT MOTION OF PLANNED BUILDING SERVICES, INC. AND THE NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD TO VOLUNTARILY DISMISS THE PETITION FOR REVIEW AND THE CROSS-APPLICATION FOR ENFORCEMENT

To the Honorable, the Judges of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit:

Pursuant to Rule 42(b) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, Planned Buildings Services, Inc. ("PBS") and the National Labor Relations Board ("the Board"), by its Acting Deputy Associate General Counsel, respectfully move the Court for leave to voluntarily dismiss PBS's petition for review the Board's crossapplication for enforcement in the above-captioned case, and show as follows:

- 1. On March 20, 2018, PBS filed a petition for review of the Board's Decision and Order in *AM Property Holding Corp.*, reported at 365 NLRB No. 162 (Dec. 15, 2017). On May 2, the Board cross-applied for enforcement of its Order. Service Employees International Union, Local 32BJ ("the Union") intervened on behalf of the Board.
- 2. The parties have reached an agreement disposing of all issues in the case and PBS has complied with that agreement, thus dispensing with the necessity for further litigation at this time.
  - 3. Each party is to bear its own attorneys' fees and costs.
- 4. Counsel for PBS, Marvin Weinberg, has authorized the Board to execute this motion on its behalf. Counsel for the Union, Andrew Strom, does not oppose the motion.

WHEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that the Clerk enter an order dismissing the petition for review and the cross-application for enforcement.
