ORDER

On July 19, 2019, Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey P. Gardner of the National Labor Relations Board issued his decision in the above-entitled proceeding and, on the same date, the proceeding was transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C. The Administrative Law Judge found that the Respondent has not engaged in certain unfair labor practices, and recommended that the complaint be dismissed.

No statement of exceptions having been filed with the Board, and the time allowed for such filing having expired,
