**ORDER TRANSFERRING PROCEEDING TO THE BOARD
and
NOTICE TO SHOW CAUSE**

On December 9, 2019, the General Counsel filed with the National Labor Relations Board a Motion to Transfer Proceedings to the Board and Motion for Default Judgment, on the ground that the Respondent has failed to file an answer to the Complaint and Notice of Hearing. Having duly considered the matter,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled proceeding be transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C., and the hearing scheduled for January 30, 2020 be postponed indefinitely.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that any party seeking to show cause why the General Counsel's motions should not be granted must do so in writing, filed with the Board in Washington, D.C., on or before December 26, 2019 (with affidavit of service on the parties to this proceeding). If a response to this Notice to Show Cause is filed, a party may file a reply to the response within 7 days of receipt of the response (with affidavit of service on the parties to this proceeding), but further responses will not be permitted except where there are special circumstances warranting leave to file such a response.
