ORDER HOLDING MOTIONS TO DISMISS IN ABEYANCE

On December 12, 2019, the Board issued an Order Remanding in *McDonald's USA, LLC*, 368 NLRB No. 134, directing that the settlement agreements in the instant case be approved, and an order issued approving the settlement agreements on December 30, 2019. On January 7, 2020, Charging Parties filed a Motion to Reopen the Record and for Reconsideration requesting that the Board reopen, reconsider, and reverse its December 12, 2019 Order Remanding.

On January 15, 2020, Counsel for the General Counsel (General Counsel) filed motions requesting permission to withdraw all of the allegations against the Respondents in the instant case, including any answers filed by Respondents. On January 16, 2020, Charging Parties filed an Opposition to General Counsel's motions to withdraw, arguing that the motions should be denied or held in abeyance pending the Board's ruling on Charging Parties' Motion to Reopen the Record and for Reconsideration.

General Counsel's January 15, 2020 motions requesting permission to withdraw the allegations against Respondents and relating pleadings will be held in abeyance pending the Board's ruling on Charging Parties' Motion to Reopen the Record and for Reconsideration.
