UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY BRIEF

Petitioner/Cross-Respondent Local 600, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America (UAW), AFL-CIO (“Local 600”), by the undersigned counsel, for its Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply Brief, pursuant to Rules 26(b) and 27 of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, states as follows:

1. Under Rule 31(a)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Local 600’s reply brief is currently due on February 20, 2020. However, after receiving an unopposed two-week extension of time, Intervenor Lloyd Stoner filed a response brief in this matter on February 13, 2020.

2. To ensure that Local 600 has adequate opportunity in its Reply Brief to address the issues raised by Intervenor and because the undersigned has a commitment to participate in out-of-state factfinding by a special master in the matter of *Sandy Alexander, Inc. v. Manroland, Inc.*, Case No. 19-cv-2461 (US Dist. Ct., N.D. Ill.), counsel respectfully requests that the Court grant Local 600 an additional one (1) week to file its Reply Brief. Under this proposed modified briefing schedule, Local 600’s Reply Brief would be due on February 27, 2020.

3. The undersigned has consulted about this modified schedule with counsel for the NLRB and Intervenor and they have no objection.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner/Cross-Respondent Local 600, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America (UAW), AFL-CIO respectfully requests that this Honorable Court grant its Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply Brief,

that the deadline for Local 600 to file its Reply Brief be extended to February 27, 2020 and that the Court take such further action as is just and appropriate.
