ORDER

On December 9, 2019, Administrative Law Judge Arthur J. Amchan of the National Labor Relations Board issued his Decision in the above-entitled proceeding and, on the same date, the proceeding was transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C. The Administrative Law Judge found that the Respondent has not engaged in certain unfair labor practices, and recommended that the complaint be dismissed.
