**MOTION OF THE NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD
FOR 10-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PAPER COPIES**

To the Honorable, the Judges of the United States
Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Assistant General Counsel, respectfully moves for a 10-day extension of time to file paper copies of its corrected answering brief. In support of its motion, the Board shows as follows:

1. On March 12, 2020, the Court granted the Board’s motion for leave to file a corrected answering brief, and the Board electronically filed its corrected answering brief.
2. The Court directed the Board to file paper copies of its corrected brief by March 17, 2020.
3. Also on March 12, and out of an abundance of caution, the Board temporarily closed its headquarters offices in Washington, D.C., to prevent

possible exposure to the Covid-19 coronavirus. The Board has since directed headquarters employees to telework through at least April 1.
